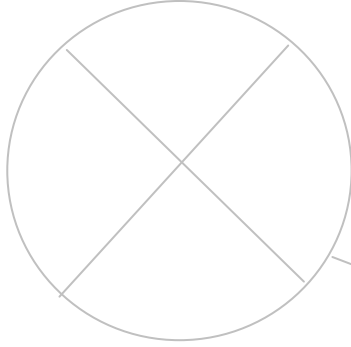

- ◆ **Neuter:** CARE will make an appointment for you to take the cat(s) to a veterinarian at Orange County Animal Services Clinic to:
 - ◆ be spayed/neutered
 - ◆ receive rabies and FVRCP shot
 - ◆ be "Ear-tipped" the cat, which is the universal symbol of a spayed/neutered feral cat.
 - ◆ be randomly tested for Feline Aids & Leukemia (if this test is positive, cat is euthanized)
- ◆ **Return:** you will need to continue to feed and care for the cats when they are returned home.

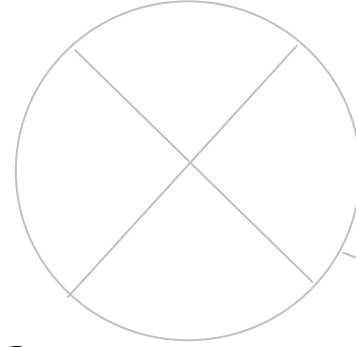
